	The Herbert Protocol is a new initiative which looks to compile useful information which	
	could be used in the event of a vulnerable person or someone suffering with dementia going missing.	
	The Herbert Protocol looks to support and safeguard members of the community, through	
	a care home/family member completing a pro-former which they will then store in a safe	
	place.	
	This pro-former can be completed in hard copy or electronically and details the following:	

	 Description and recent photograph Places of interest/addresses of note Jobs, interest and hobbies Medical information Details of their routine 	
	In the event a person goes missing you then hand the pro-former to police, which reduces the time taken to gather key information. As a result, this allows for a prompt and effective search and promotes their safe return.
