Cycling TOB Legacy.

No new report as Suzie was not at the meeting. The action point from the last meeting has still to be carried out.

Looking for funding support from Rural Development to deliver a number of smaller projects. Been meeting with CEBC to look at areas (eg Biddulph Valley Way – Brook St, Astbury Mere using a tourism link. Have been carrying out surveys at various points as evidence of need. SAS to keep Glen Williams (Highways) into the look. Again little support coming in from CEBC officers. SAS to arrange a "high" level meeting with Cllr R. Bailey (leader) possibly Cabinet member for Health & Wellbeing (Cllr Wardlaw), one of the ward members for Congleton, D.McGifford and S.Foster.

Senior Health & Wellbeing Fayre.

Planned for early 2nd October. A joint venture with Mid Cheshire NHS Trust as they are planning a Fayre/Annual Meeting around that time. 40 exhibitors confirmed ranging from Clinical, health services, community centres and local groups. Next subgroup meeting 29th August. Posters and flyers printed and will be circulated in September.

Connected Communities Centres.

The Partnership is currently working with CEBC Connected Communities Team to set up 4 CC Centres in Congleton.

These are The Old Saw Mill, Ruby's Fund, Parnell Sq Hub and Bromley Farm Community Centre. Small amount of funding will be provided to each site by CEBC to cover room hire so that service providers/organisations can deliver their programmes to meet local demand.

All the centres are currently going through the GRIPP programme and should be active as centres
